You will be staying at the Sonora Aladdin Motor Inn located just outside of town on Hwy 108. The room rate will be \$104.00 per night (minimum 2 nights stay). All rooms are non-smoking. You may request 1 or 2 beds at the same price. Brochures are enclosed as to directions. The phone number to call for reservations is (800) 696-3969. The online website is www.aladdininn.com. Just tell them you are with the Square Dance Council Meeting. You must make your reservation by July 13th. That doesn't mean there will not be any rooms, but you will be taking a chance of the availability. We are a tourist community and rooms are at a premium especially during the summer months for this motel which is very popular with visitors. The nearest airport is Modesto which is west of Sonora and about 1 hours drive.

ALL meetings will be held at the Best Western Motel just around the corner from the Aladdin at their Oak Glen Building. It is very spacious and will accommodate a large number of people. We will have a hospitality room set up for all at the Aladdin just next to the pool area.
