



Jerry Schatzer Scholarship Fund

Purpose of the Fund

In compliance with the wishes and objectives of Jerry Schatzer, proceeds from the Fund will be used exclusively for disbursement to callers on a scholarship award basis.

Fund Disbursements:

Scholarships shall be awarded based on the following priorities: need, existing skills, training, and intentions.

In his lifetime Jerry Schatzer was mostly concerned that callers continue their education through additional schooling. Therefore, priority in award selection shall be given to callers who have already attended a caller school, or who have been calling more than five years at the time of application. However, this is not meant to limit applicants only to those who have already been calling five or more years. Any caller, or aspiring caller can apply. In the event that no experienced callers have applied, a new caller can and should, receive an award, all other factors considered.

No single award shall exceed 75% of the combined cost of tuition and room and board, if room and board are a normal part of the cost of the school and only if the participant takes advantage of the room and board. Otherwise, no single award shall exceed 75% of the tuition cost, and no award shall exceed \$200.

In the event that a husband/wife or other "team" of callers should apply, any award given the "team" shall not exceed \$400 in total. The award shall not exceed 75% of combined tuition cost, and room and board cost, if applicable.

Applicants must complete the enclosed application form in its present or later amended form. **Applications will be accepted at the CALLERLAB Home Office until May 1st of each award year. All applications received by May 1st will be considered by the CALLERLAB Executive Committee. Applications received after May 1st shall not be considered.** Each applicant must submit a written essay. This essay must include: 1) statement of need: 2) and a statement of intention. Those callers whose intentions include, but are not limited to, pursuing calling as a full time profession, shall be given priority in the selection process.

No single individual shall receive more than one scholarship award from this Fund. No husband/wife or other "team" shall receive more than one scholarship award from this Fund, considered jointly or severally

Purpose of the Fund
(Revised September 16, 2002)**

In compliance with the wishes and objectives of George White, proceeds from the Fund will be used for disbursement to CALLERLAB members on a scholarship award basis.

Fund Disbursements:

Scholarships will be awarded based on the following priorities: need, existing skills, training, and intentions.

Applicants shall be limited to CALLERLAB members who are applying to attend a caller school with at least one Accredited CALLERLAB Caller-Coach on staff. Priority in award selections shall be given to callers who have been calling more than three years at the time of application. However, this is not meant to limit applicants only to those who have already been calling three or more years. In the event that no experienced callers have applied, a new caller can and should, receive an award, all other factors considered.

No single award shall exceed 75% of the combined cost of tuition and room and board, if room and board are a normal part of the cost of the school and only if the participant takes advantage of the room and board. Otherwise, no single award shall exceed 75% of the tuition cost, and no award shall exceed \$200.

Applicants shall complete the enclosed application form in its present or later amended form. **Applications will be accepted at the CALLERLAB Home Office until May 1st of each award year. All applications received by May 1st will be considered by the CALLERLAB Executive Committee. In compliance with the wishes and objectives of Bill & Peggy Heyman, proceeds from the Fund are intended for use by a deserving caller who has a background of calling or dancing; and who has indicated a desire to learn to call or a desire to improve their calling.

Fund Disbursements:

Scholarships shall be awarded based on the following priorities: need, existing skills, training and intentions.

No single award shall exceed 75% of the combined cost of tuition and room and board, if room and board are a normal part of the cost of the school and only if the participant takes advantage of the room and board. Otherwise, no single award shall exceed 75% of the tuition cost, and no award shall exceed \$200.

In the event that a husband/wife or other "team" of callers should apply, any award given the "team" shall not exceed \$400 in total. The award shall not exceed 75% of combined tuition costs, and room and board costs if applicable.

Applicants must complete the enclosed application form in its present or later amended form. **Applications will be accepted at the CALLERLAB Home Office until May 1st of each award year. All applications received by May 1st will be considered by the CALLERLAB Executive Committee.** The application contains a statement of intention. Each applicant must complete the statement of intention. Those callers whose intentions include, but are not limited to, pursuing calling as a full time profession, shall be given priority in the selection process.

No single individual shall receive more than one scholarship award from this Fund. No husband/wife or other "team" shall receive more than one scholarship award from this Fund, considered jointly or severally.
